History of The Punch Bowl Inn

The punch bowl inn is over 400 years old, the actual date when the pub was first built is unknown. It was originally a hundred house and was first licensed in 1740. It was named Ye Olde Punch Bowl Inn in the middle of the 19th Century, probably because of its association with the Whig party who were traditionally Sherry and Punch Drinkers.. During the seize of Bridgnorth many of Oliver Cromwells troops were billeted in the house.

Rumour has it, that the inn was one of many buildings in the 17th Century that was connected to a network of tunnels beneath Bridgnorth and its believed that a tunnel was connected to the 'hundred house' opposite the pub.

Whilst undergoing renovations October 2005 we discovered an old business card hidden away from previous proprietors years back. We were impressed with the poetry and their views on the general public so we decided the reprint an extract from the original business card.
